 - managing technical on and off-site designs
 - managing electrical grid connections as well as other utilities
 - obtaining relevant environmental permits
 - managing consultants, suppliers and partners
 - anticipating and mitigating development risk
 - budgetary and development program responsibility
 - other related development requirements
