KEMPSTON WEST END, BEDFORD**

**(132kV Overhead Electric Line Connection from the proposed Snakes Meadow Solar Farm to the existing pylon  
tower operated by UK Power Networks)**

Pursuant to the above Regulations, notice is hereby given that Renewable Connections Developments Limited, registered office: 141-145 Curtain Road, Floor 3, London, England, EC2A 3BX has submitted to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, an application for consent under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 and deemed planning permission under section 90(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for overhead electric line connection works from the proposed Snakes Meadow Solar Farm to the existing pylon tower operated by UK Power Networks.

The works comprise the proposed installation of a new 132kV electrical overhead line ('OHL') of approximately 15 metres in length. The Proposed OHL is required to connect the proposed Snakes Meadow Solar Farm point of connection compound into a nearby existing high voltage pylon tower.
